Very Important Information

- The children need to arrive at the theatre **1 hour** before each performance.
- The children are required to be at the theatre from one hour before the performance begins, right up until the final scene, when they will come back out onto the stage to take their well-earned curtesy or bow.
- Please pick your child up in between performances so they can have a good rest in between shows. They will need to return the theatre **1 hour** before the next performance.
- Your child should arrive at the theatre wearing their nude underwear or undertard (if unsure please see teacher), and ballet tights, underneath a front opening top, onesie, or dressing gown. They must also bring the shoes that they will be dancing in, ballet shoes or character shoes. Please make sure that everything that comes to the theatre is clearly named.

Makeup Kit Essentials

Makeup

- *Foundation to match skin tone
- *Blusher
- *Brown eyeshadow palette – light/cream colour plus darker shade of brown
- *Black eyeliner
- *Eyebrow pencil to match natural eyebrow colour
- *Red lipstick – very rich bright red for stage lighting – if you decide to purchase through Minifies it is their Kryolan LC008

Hair

- *Bun pins
- *Bobby Pins
- *Bun net to match hair colour
- *Gel
- *Hairspray

- All makeup (except for eye flicks and lipstick) should be applied before the children arrive at the theatre. Dancers must bring their own named eye liner pencil and lipstick to the theatre with them.
- Most dancers will need to arrive at the theatre with their hair in a ballet bun (unless their teacher has specifically instructed otherwise). Tip- it is best to leave hair unwashed for a few days before the show. Use plenty of gel and hairspray (NOT the sparkly, glittery kind please).

On the Day Dancers should bring.....

- Plenty of healthy snacks, (not greasy, messy ones) eg: crackers and cheese, cut up fruit, carrot sticks, dried fruit, etc.
- Water bottle – water only at the theatre please.
- Quiet activities, colouring in books, colouring pencils (no felt tips, crayons or pens please), a book to read, loom bands, maybe a card game.

Items that should NOT be brought to the theatre....

- No nail polish on finger nails or toe nails please
- No Nuts
- No sticky foods eg: yoghurt, hot chips, highly coloured food, lollipops, chocolate bars, fizzy drinks, juice, etc (none of these are kind to our costumes)
- No crayons, felt tip pens/markers
- No jewellery or earrings
- No visible tattoos (permanent or temporary)
- No valuable items – any valuable items are bought at your own risk
